Dear Parents/Carers

Austerfield Residential Trip - Year 3, 4 and 5

Residential visits have always been an important part of your child's education at Misson Primary School, and it has been a source of great regret that the COVID pandemic has stopped these visits taking place. However we have been given the opportunity to take the children in years 3, 4 and 5 to a one night residential at Austerfield Study Centre this term.

We would also like to take years 4 and 5 away for 2 nights in May next year, so they can catch up on the visits they have missed over the last 18 months.

The Austerfield visit will run from Monday 4th October – Tuesday 5th October 2021. We shall be staying at Austerfield Study Centre and the children will be supervised by staff at all times. Children will be taking part in various activities such as team building and educational activities about rocks, including a visit to the local quarry.

The cost of the trip will be **£40** which includes accommodation, food and all activities. A kit list will be issued nearer the time, if you have any questions please contact Mrs Tanner or Mr Birch.

We would be grateful if you could arrange for your child to be taken to the Centre for 9am on Monday the 4th of October. The children can be collected from the centre from 3.00 pm on Tuesday the 5th of October to allow parents to collect other children from school at the normal end of school time.

When dropping off and collecting your child please pull into the quarry entrance just before the Study Centre. You can then access the centre via the back gate. We will be there to welcome them on arrival.

Please use ParentPay to pay a deposit of £10 by Monday 20th September. As the notice for this visit is very short, payment of the balance can be made up to 17th December 2021.

We hope that all year 3, 4 and 5 children will be able to attend this residential. However, if you think your child may not be able to attend, please speak with us as soon as possible.
