Lincolnshire Consortium of Grammar Schools' Admissions Procedure for entry in September 2023

This information is for parents of children who are due to transfer to secondary school in September 2023 and may be considering entry to Queen Elizabeth's High School.

You are probably aware that the testing procedure is carried out by the grammar schools and not by the Local Authority. Lincolnshire grammar schools use Verbal and Non-Verbal Reasoning tests that are specifically produced by GL Assessment. There will be two tests, both at the beginning of Year 6, and these tests will be administered by Queen Elizabeth's High School. This, however, does not prevent you from choosing a grammar school in another area.

11+ Familiarisation papers sat at QEHS

CHILDREN ARE ADVISED TO ATTEND BOTH PRACTICE PAPERS since one paper will be Verbal Reasoning and one will be Non-Verbal Reasoning. The tests are designed so that attending two practice tests will be adequate preparation. However, if you are unable to attend the practice tests you can purchase commercially printed practice papers by GL Assessment from Amazon or other online retailers. These come in packs, together with a guide for parents and a simplified administration and mark scheme. The content of the commercially available 11+ practice papers is representative of the actual test papers but not identical. The actual tests may include item types which are not in the practice papers, or omit item types which are. Since the actual tests are designed to customers' specific requirements, the format and layout may also differ from the standard practice papers. Nonetheless, the practice papers give children an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the general nature of the tests and to practice aspects such as following instructions carefully and working to a time limit. Parents should purchase the **MULTIPLE CHOICE FORMAT** NOT the Standard Format papers:

24 September 2022

Second 11+ Test – Non-Verbal Reasoning will take place in this school.

Final date for submitting Common Application Form to Local Authority. *(If your LA is not Lincolnshire, please check the date on your form)*

1 March 2023

Offers of secondary school places made available to parents by their own LA. Parents have the right to appeal against non-admission and are advised to discuss this with their child's primary headteacher

2 March 2023

Grammar schools will write to parents confirming the grammar school place offered.

If you wish your child to sit the 11+ tests for entry to a Lincolnshire grammar school in September 2022, it is vital that you complete the online registration form **by no later than Friday 25 March 2022**. You need to be aware however, that this in itself does not constitute an application to a particular grammar school.
