Membership:

The governing body of Misson Primary School is determined by the instrument of Government and re-constituted 23rd February 2015, as per the requirements of the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012. The governing body is now made up of 12 members:

- 2 Parent Governors - elected from the Parent Body;
- 1 LEA Governor - appointed by the governing body on behalf of the LEA;
- 2 Staff Governors (including Head Teacher);
- 7 Co-opted Governors - appointed by the the governors body for specific skills and to represent the community
