Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you have been enjoying the sunny weather, we certainly have at school, but at the risk of indulging the great British tradition of complaining about the weather, I would like to let you know about the measures we are taking to protect our children from the higher than normal temperatures.

We will be doing the following:

Inside

- Closing blinds and curtains to prevent sunlight from entering the classrooms
- Moving lessons to cooler areas of the school
- Ensuring there is adequate ventilation of pure or fresh air in the classrooms
- Moderating pupils' physical activity
- Moving PE lessons to cooler times of the school day where possible
- Allow children access to water in lessons

Outside

- Encouraging children to stay in shaded areas at break times.
- Not using the field due to limited availability of shade
- Encouraging children to wear sun hats/caps
- Encouraging children to apply sunscreen when they go outside
- Encouraging children to moderate their physical activity
- Encouraging children to drink water as required

Parents and Carers can help by:

- Providing their children with sun screen and after sun
- Ensuring the children have a sun hat or cap to school every day
- Ensuring their children bring a clearly named water bottle to school every day
- Reinforce with their children the messages about staying in the shade and reducing physical activity.
